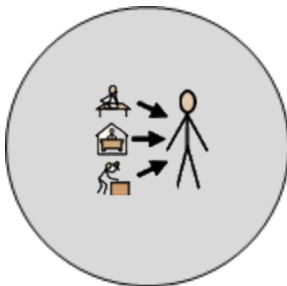
We help you build skills, knowledge and confidence for work, adult life and the future.



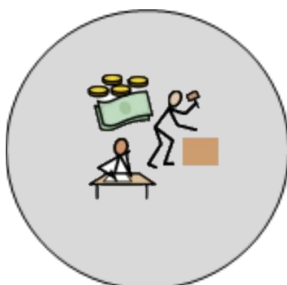
There are lots of people at college who can support you with your future plans.

Futures Lessons – Learn about jobs, opportunities, adult life and future choices.



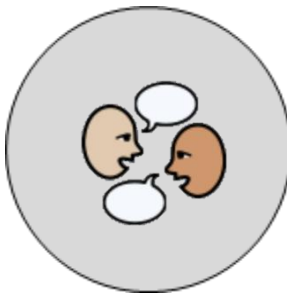
Careers Advice Meetings – Talk to a careers adviser about your strengths, interests and future goals.

Encounters with Employers – Meet employers and employees to learn about jobs, skills and work.



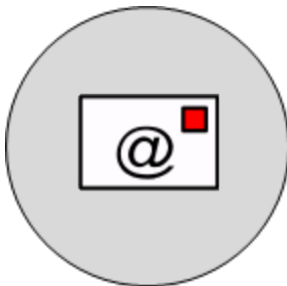
Find out about jobs, training and opportunities in your local area.
